

**2010 FEE SCHEDULES  
DALLAS BASEBALL UMPIRE ASSOCIATION**

**Game Fees:**

- All games on all levels and in all situations (tournament games) will be billed at \$50 per game.
- Exception:
  - Sunnyvale ISD must be billed at \$45 per game on all levels and in all situations due to unusual circumstances.

**Travel Fees**

- Mileage will be calculated roundtrip from the home address to the game site and back.
- The official traveling the greatest distance to the game site will multiply his mileage by \$.55 per mile.
- The \$10 rider fee for the other official (the one traveling the fewest miles) will be added to the full mileage and the amount divided equally.
- This is the amount each official shall enter on his pay sheet that is turned in, or on the one that you may have to fill out for the school.
- Be sure to distinctly indicate the mileage fee on school forms if it is not readily indicated on the form.
- **Exception:**
  - Sunnyvale ISD has agreed to pay each official full mileage as compensation for the lower game fee.

**Calculating Mileage**

- Under “Sites/Contacts” on each official’s home page you can access MapQuest for each game site.
- Go to “Sites/Contact” and find the game site indicated on your schedule at which you are to work.
- Click on the address and it will bring up the location on MapQuest.
- At the top under the game site address you will click on “Directions To.”
- Enter your home address and click “Get Directions.”
- At the top just above “Fuel Costs” you will see the estimated mileage to the game site.
- Double this and it will be the figure used to multiple by \$.55 for the full mileage to be paid.
- Again, the official that travels the greatest distance will multiple his mileage by the \$.55.
- Use this figure to figure your mileage without having to use your odometer on your way to the game site.
